Lisa Lahey RN, IBCLC, OMT will discuss prevalence, symptoms, assessment, and exam technique and treatment of tethered oral tissues. She will describe the IBCLC role before and after frenectomy involving a team approach with other healthcare professionals. The afternoon session will have in person *live* assessment with babies and hands-on application to suck training and aftercare.

This presentation will prepare the learner to: Define and describe ankyloglossia signs, symptoms, physical attributes of TOTS, review principles of feeding and oral motor assessment as it relates to breastfeeding child, review assessment and evaluation technique evidenced by lap to lap exam, and use of assessment tools such as Hazelbaker, Martinelli, Dobrich Tools, discuss strategies to educate patients/parents on what to expect before, during, after frenectomy, describe and demonstrate post frenectomy aftercare and rehabilitation oral exercises such as suck training and myofunctional exercises.

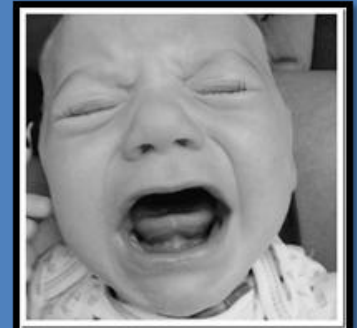
