Dr. Borgelt has extensive knowledge of cannabis with regards to its pharmacology, pharmacokinetics, pharmacodynamics, therapeutic effectiveness, and potential risks. Her evidence-based, balanced approach to identifying potential benefits and risks of cannabis is important to determine its appropriate use.
